

Call for Adjunct Instructors Binghamton Codes! Program

The Binghamton Codes! Program is currently seeking Adjunct Instructors for the 2023-24 academic year. Instructors must demonstrate a history of student-centered teaching and a working knowledge of the Python language. Instructors will teach pre-built courses with approximately 100 students and will have undergraduate course assistants to help lead labs and assist with grading.

The two courses are:

- HARP 150: Intro to Coding (Python) [[see syllabus](#)]
 - Covers everything from data types to OOP and includes a basic overview of data analysis using pandas and matplotlib
- HARP 151: Programming in Action [[see syllabus](#)]
 - Covers basic HTML/CSS skills, Web Scraping, APIs, and GUIs (Tkinter)

Requirements:

- Lead weekly lectures
- Update weekly lab assignments when necessary
- Oversee course grading
- Build and monitor Brightspace course page
- Oversee a team of course assistants (between 4-8)
- Hold three office hours per week
- Hold regular check-ins with Program Director about course progress
