# Rule of Law:

individuals must recognize and accept that the law is necessary to regulate society. Law applies equally to everyone, including people in power, such as heads of state, police officers, judges and politicians

no one in our society has the authority to exercise unrestricted power to take our rights away except in accordance with the law







Example: based on the will of the majority
