## **Meeting Notes**

#### Main points

- Next meeting is hopefully a short one at 9am on 25 Jan primarily to rehash stuff we can't resolve online in the chat and do a final confirmation. We mainly need to resolve the schedule, and any disagreements.
- 2. We will tentatively start the second season of SICBF from 2nd week of May and have 2 games in May, 2 in June, 1 in July, 2 in Aug, and 2 in Sep. Culminating in a finale to be held in October. JM to publish a tentative schedule asap so that clubs can try to slot in.
  - a. Similar to last year, with 9 clubs, it will be a 9 round, round robin format. Hosts sit out, 8 tables per round with 8 teams contesting head to head.

- We are looking for a club that can host a finale. We had 20 tables in the first season. We now have an expanded group of 9 clubs. CSC cannot host (ballroom under renovation).
  3 possible clubs (possibly NUSS might as well.).
- 4. Chairperson is still JM for now. However, will be amending the constitution so that in principle, all clubs may nominate a chairperson and if there is more than one, we will vote for the chairperson.
- 5. JM needs to work on a "Guide for Players" and a "Guide for Hosts".
  - a. "Guide for players" is basically an etiquette guide. We want to avoid a repeat of any incident where a player mis-behaves.
  - b. "Guide for hosts" will include a how-to to score electronically without error.
- 6. All clubs agreed that a 8 table round should be doable.
- 7. We agreed to leave the matter of funding, resourcing etc an independent matter for hosts to self-resolve (though with help from others if necessary).
- 8. Throughout this year, JM will be trying to figure out how to have a proper organization of SICBF with a view that it may become a permanent part of the bridge calendar (e.g. a proper website for SICBF).
