Students may apply for as many scholarships as they wish, providing they meet the scholarship qualifications. However, typically students find only about five to ten scholarships in which they actually meet the qualifications. Take those five to ten scholarships and put all your energy into the application and make them perfect. Neatness is vital and mailing the scholarship before the deadline is very important. Stay organized and diligent. Scholarships can be lucrative and you deserve the chance to succeed in this area. If a scholarship notes you must be nominated, ask your school counselor or teacher to nominate you!

If there is no website address listed under the scholarship criteria, you need to pick up the application from the Counseling Center.
