- a. Looking to pour new throwers pads before winter
- b. We will be running water to the FFA property. We have decided to build a meter pit to make the best use of cost in the future between water running to the FFA Property, Football field, practice field, and concession stand.
 - i. Currently have 2 meters that have a meter fee plus usage.
 - ii. Adding water to the FFA Property would cost another meter fee plus usage.
 - iii. With a meter pit, we can run all of them off the same meter and save on meter fees (\$100+/mo per meter). At the current cost, assuming no increase, it will take 5-10 years to recoup the cost of running water to the FFA property plus digging a meter pit. If you count for increasing costs per meter, then the savings will meet us sooner.
 - iv. The pit will be dug first thing in the spring. One hydrant will be put next to the garden, one will be placed by the building, another line will be plumbed to add any additional hydrants we may need.
