Breaking News! Coup Developing In Colombia

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Summary of the situation

Early morning on Tuesday, April 20th, our journalists in the area, who were reporting on the ongoing political crisis in Colombia, informed us of a concerning and rapid escalation in events in the capital of San Antero. From the information that we were able to gather it seems that armed members of the Colombian military have violently stormed the government building. This comes after previous escalations throughout last night between different factions of protesters, the police, and the Colombian military.



Detailed events

The escalation started when pro La Cruz protesters clashed with protesters supporting the PL party outside the parliament building. Anti-riot police and the local Colombian garrison were forced to respond and quell the violence.

From what we could gather at approximately 04:00 local time, local militants and pro PL protesters took the opportunity to raid the local garrison in San Antero, capturing much of the army's lethal equipment. We now believe with the information gathered, that this was an organized plan by FARC rebels to distract the army in order to capture their equipment.

At approximately 05:00 local the streets of San Antero resembled more of a warzone as armed clashes and fires raged throughout the city.

An hour later, at 06:00 local, an armed convoy was seen moving from a nearby military installation into the city. We have unconfirmed reports that when this convoy arrived at the parliament building, firefights broke out in a confusing situation of who is who, as protesters fired on the convoy.

We now know that this convoy was led by General Diego Andres, an influential Colombian officer with ties to the PL party. After his seizure of parliament, Andres took to the local news radio declaring martial law and that the military will be restoring order to the city. This led to many more violent clashes between all parties.

At 12:24 local, a news conference was held at the Colombian parliament building, where prominent PL party senator, Luis Marin along with General Diego Andres, declared the government of Colombia to be dissolved, with the PL party taking over all duties until fair and safe elections can be held. In a short video he declared:

“My dear friends. The terrorist regime is no longer here. We of the PL are here to restore order and peace in the beautiful lands of Colombia. Do not fear the changes that are coming. Don't be afraid of troop movements. Do not fear your neighbor. We are stronger together. We are stronger without the West. Thank you for your patience in these unprecedented times as we reorient the great country of Colombia to the East.”

“Mis queridos amigos. El régimen terrorista ya no está aquí. Los del PL estamos aquí para restaurar el orden y la paz en las hermosas tierras de Colombia. No temas los cambios que se avecinan. No temas los movimientos de tropas. No temas a tu prójimo. Somos más fuertes juntos. Somos más fuertes sin Occidente. Gracias por su paciencia en estos tiempos sin precedentes, mientras reorientamos el gran país de Colombia hacia el Este.”
