## Here is the outline for summer parades and rehearsals 2025:

#### Band Slam Rehearsal, Friday, June 13th:

8:45 AM- Ready to go in the band room.

9:00 AM- Bus leaves with or without you to Hancock High School.

9:30 AM- Rehearse with HHS

11:00 AM- Load bus and return to LL after stopping for lunch in Houghton (students must pay for their own lunch).

#### **Bridge Fest Parade, Friday, June 13th:**

4:30 PM- Be ready in band room

5:00 PM- Bus leaves with or without you.

6:00 PM- Arrive for parade line-up.

- -Line up: Ohio Street (by Lahti insurance) between S. Lincoln and Quincy
- -Parent drop off option: BHK parking lot
- -6:30p start time

End at gas station at Franklin St. and College Ave. (Hancock will do parent pick up at this parking lot)

#### Fourth of July Parades on Friday, July 4:

8:30 am - Students report to LLH band room to get equipment out and warm up.

9:30 am - Lake Linden Parade

When done, we load the bus (all students travel on bus) and go to the Hubbell/Tamarack City Parade.

10:30 am - Hubbell/Tamarack City Parade

When done, we load the bus (all students travel on bus) and go to the Dollar Bay Parade.

Water will be available at the end - PLEASE make sure that students also bring water bottles with them on the bus for between parades, and possibly snacks. When done, return to Lake Linden.

#### **Strawberry Festival Parade on Sat, July 12:**

9:00 am - Students report to the LLH band room to get equipment out and warm up and load bus.

9:15 am - Bus departs for Dollar Bay to pick up DB students (at approx. 9:30 am), continues to Chassell

10:00 am - Arrive in Chassell

10:45 am - Line up for 11:00 Parade



11:40 am - Load bus and return DB students to Dollar Bay, then continue home to Lake Linden.

**Uniform:** We will be wearing full uniform for the 4th of july parade and strawberry festival parades. Wear shorts and a Lakes T-shirt underneath the uniform. A "Band Slam" T-shirt will be provided for Bridge Fest at the cost of \$15 per student, wear black shorts with the band slam Tee. No open toed shoes. Please wear tennis shoes for all parades (sunglasses are allowed).
