- DNSSEC including DNS Security & Abuse
- ICANN's Accountability & Transparency
- Internationalized Domain Names (IDNs) & Universal Acceptance (UA)
- Competition, Consumer Trust & Consumer Choice
- Geographic Names



CAPACITY BUILDING NEEDS

The survey also identified certain needs:

- Training & developing the skills of members in ICANN policy drafting & commenting
- Schools of Internet Governance (SIG)
- Supporting members in ICANN public policy drafting and commenting
- Development of local language or language neutral materials for Regional and Local use



OTHER TOPICS & ITEMS OF IMPORTANCE


The survey also yielded interest in broader Internet Governance topics of:
