

Lovely Arrangements: Hello Friend

Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Lovely Arrangements* (167169)
- **Paper** – Basic White Thick Cardstock (159229); Old Olive Cardstock (100702); Lovely Blossoms Designer Series Paper (167168)
- **Stamp Pads** – Secret Sea (165285); Old Olive (147090)
- **Stampin' Blends** – none
- **Misc.** Lovely Arrangements Dies* (167175); Stylish Shapes Dies (159183); Moody Palette Glossy Dots (167180); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430)

Measurements:

- Basic White Thick Cardstock: 8 ½" x 5 ½"; 1 ¾" x 4"; 3 ¼" x 1"
- Old Olive Cardstock: 3" x 3"
- Lovely Blossoms Designer Series Paper (DSP): pattern one: 2 ¼" x 3 ½" and 1 ¾" x 3 ½"; pattern two: 2 ¼" x 1 ¾" and 1 ¾" x 1 ¾"; pattern three: 2 ¼" x 2 ½" (for stamping flower)

Instructions:

1. Score and fold the 8 ½" x 5 ½" Basic White Thick cardstock at 4 ¼" to create the card base.
2. Attach Lovely Blossoms Designer Series Paper (patterns one and two) to the card front, referring to the card photo for placement.
3. Using Secret Sea ink, stamp the following: the large flower onto pattern three of the designer series paper and the sentiment onto the 3 ¼" x 1" strip of Basic White Thick cardstock. Die cut the flower and sentiment banner with the coordinating Lovely Arrangement Dies.
4. Stamp two sets of the leaves using Old Olive ink onto the 1 ¾" x 4" piece of Basic White Thick cardstock. Use the coordinating die to cut the two sets of leaves.

5. Cut the Old Olive cardstock using the second largest Stylish Shapes circle die. Attach to the center of the card using liquid adhesive.
6. Add the leaves to the Old Olive circle with adhesive and layer the flower on top using Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Place Stampin' Dimensionals on each end of the sentiment back and attach to the card front, placing it across the lower portion of the flower.
8. Complete by embellishing with the Moody Palette Glossy Dots.
