Each person in the group needs to choose 4 places that you want to vacation to that can have a geology focus.

Make a google powerpoint (and share it with me) that includes

- -at least 4 slides (hopefully more because you should have some awesome pictures you want to share) for each location,
  - Slide One- Name of Location and a map that shows us where it is at to give us perspective of where this is at in the world
  - Slide Two- A picture and description of what time period this location dates to
  - Slide Three- Another Picture that you show the class as you explain how this location relates to Geology. How did this formation come to be, what is its history and its relation to geology? (Could be faults, types of rocks, types of minerals, fossil types) This does not need to be typed. You should be able to explain this.
  - Slide Four (and more)- More pictures that show off just how amazing this location is as you relate it to geology

- You can choose some of the popular ones such as Yellowstone, Grand Canyon, etc, but try to expand yourself to find some other cool places that you could visit. What are some of the cool hidden gems out there? Within your group, only one person can choose each location. For example, not all of you can have Yellowstone. If there are 4 of you in your group, you should have 12 different locations.

- like meteor impact craters
- like caves?
- like mountains?
- like finding your own gold, uranium, or diamonds?
- like warm/cold/dry/wet places?
