

## Linking, the Anchor Tag and the Movie Project



We can link to things on the Internet by using the anchor tag

<a href ="http:/google.com">Google</a>

- will link to the Google web site. Between the ancher tags <a> </a> we put what we want to appear on screen. When we click on that word or image it will bring us to the href site
- When we say <a href ="text.html">Test</a> we are saying that if you click on the word Test your program would open up the tst.html page. The test.html page would be in your folder since you didn't add the Internet addressing
- if you say
- <a href ="http://ibm.com">IBM</a>
- you will go to the IBM web site when you click on the word IBM. Adding the http tell the HTML that you are linking to a web page, not in your folder, but out on the Internet
- if you say

<a href ="http://ge.com"><img src ="ge.jpg"></a>

you are using an image as a link. If you click on the ge.jpg image then you will open up the ge web page

- For your Project you will write an HTML page that will list your Top Ten Moves and have links to IMDB that will tell you about the movie
- Below you will see some code to help get you started

- The above code has a picture that you uploaded to your pics folder. It also links to the IMDB movie site.
   if you click on The Godfather it will bring you to that site.
- You should have 10 movies like this on your page. You will get the URL to link to by going to IMDB.com
  and typing in the name of your movie. You will then copy the URL from the URL window
- Make your page look as good as possible by experimenting with colors and fonts
