

Jackson Independent School District Chromebook Bid Evaluation Rubric

This rubric will be used to evaluate bids for the Chromebook replacement at Jackson Independent Middle School and High School based on key criteria. Each bid will be rated on a scale from 1 to 5 in each category, with 5 representing the highest score. The final score will guide our selection process.

| Criteria | Description | Rating Scale |
|---|--|--|
| Cost-effectiveness | Assesses whether the bid offers a competitive price relative to the market and aligns with budgetary expectations. | 1 = Very High Cost, 5 = Best Value |
| Product Specifications | Evaluates if the devices meet the required specifications (Dell touch-screen 2-in-1 functionality, high-resolution screen, durability). | 1 = Does Not Meet, 5 = Exceeds Specifications |
| Google Chrome Education Licenses | Confirms inclusion of Google Chrome Education Licenses for all devices as requested. | 1 = Not Included, 5 = Fully Included |
| Warranty and Support Options | Considers the duration and quality of warranty coverage and any additional support options (e.g., extended warranties, on-site support). | 1 = Limited Warranty/Support, 5 = Comprehensive Warranty/Support |
| Delivery Schedule | Evaluates whether the proposed delivery timeline aligns with the District's needs for prompt deployment. | 1 = Significantly Delayed, 5 = Meets/Exceeds Timeline |
| Vendor Reputation | Considers the vendor's experience, reliability, and reputation, especially in providing educational technology solutions. | 1 = Low Reputation, 5 = Excellent Reputation |

Scoring Guide:

- **5 (Excellent):** Fully meets or exceeds expectations in this criterion.
- **4 (Good):** Meets expectations with minor limitations.
- **3 (Satisfactory):** Meets basic expectations but lacks some features or benefits.
- **2 (Below Average):** Falls short of expectations in a significant way.
- **1 (Poor):** Does not meet expectations for this criterion.

Final Score Calculation: Each bid will be scored out of 30 possible points. The bid with the highest score that meets all requirements will be prioritized in the selection process.
