



In 4 ½ weeks, we started and finished making cutting boards to sell. We first grabbed a cherry off the woodpile. Then cut it to 15" on the cutoff saw. Then ripped the boards at 1 ¼" on the table saw. Then we glued the boards together, making cutting boards that are 14"x10".

After the glue dried, we planed and sanded the boards. Later, we rounded all the edges and oiled them. We are now starting the next project, boot jacks.
