

CHECK IT OUT ... iTrace teaches students

correct letter and number formation and provides multiple opportunities for practice to develop muscle memory. When a student chooses a letter, number, or word to write, the formation is modeled. If the finger is placed in the wrong starting position or moves in the wrong direction, the app repeats the model. Parents can enter the Parent Zone and set the model we use at school (Zaner-Bloser) and check the child's practice history. Learn more at www.itraceapp.com.
