This portion of the final exam is a digital portfolio self-reflection. It is expected that the reflection reach 750 words. If it does not reach the 750 word minimum, the author can earn no more than 75% on this portion of the exam.

You will need to use your Edublogs as a basis for your reflection by using the portfolio pieces to prove your opinion.

Accompanying these will be your self-reflection analysis:

- Discuss your growth and effort as a reader, writer and thinker,
- Share a particular moment of intellectual risk-taking,
- Consider a growth territory that you still need to pursue in the future,
- Share your overall assessment of yourself as a reader, writer, and critical thinker.

Showcase pieces on your Edublogs.

Look it over.

Think about it.

Have you tried?

Have you given your all?

Have you improved?

Prove it.
