#### Set up your Pit Table

Each team will be provided with one table. Teams may decorate tables and can bring items to exchange with other teams, (buttons, pencils, etc.). Please do not bring any noise makers. Each team is responsible for their personal belongings that they bring to the meet. Do not leave valuables unattended. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items. Have all of your equipment marked with your team number, most importantly your batteries and chargers. You may consider bringing a tub or trash bag for storing coats and such under your

table. Due to space constraint you may not be given a 10 foot by 10 foot space. Respect the space given and keep aisle ways clear.

# Power Availability in the Pit Area

Plan to have laptops, phones, and batteries fully charged before arriving. No power tool use, such as cutting or grinding at pit tables. There will be a charging table for teams to use for their batteries that power the robots.

# **Required Items to Bring**

- Safety Glasses for all team members and visitors to the pits. Everyone in the pit area or competing at
  the field is required to wear safety glasses or have side shields on their prescription glasses. Safety
  glasses will NOT be provided.
- Team Roster from the FIRST dashboard, press the big blue button to print. All students need to be electronically registered and listed on the roster. Electronic consent and release forms need to be signed for each team member.
- A completed Inspection Checklist (highly suggested)
  - Inspection Checklist

  - #2 issue Maximum Servos <R503>
  - #3 issue Maximum Motors <R503>
  - #4 issue Size of robot <R101, R105, G414, G415>
- Robot, Tools, Batteries, Chargers, Computers, Controllers, USB cables, etc.
