High jump - starting height for girls will be 1.2m graduations of 5cm up to 1.35m. 2.5cm graduations after 1.35

Starting height for boys will be 1.32m. Graduations of 5cm up to 1.52m. 2.5cm graduations after 1.52m

Long Jump: Girls followed by Boys – 3 jumps allowed

Triple Jump - Boys will jump first followed by girls - 3 jumps allowed
