The Service

- 1. Set the date and time
 - a. Coordinate with family and friends: Ensure key people can attend
 - b. Check availability of the venue, officiant, musician, cemetery (for the burial), and funeral home. The funeral home should help with most, if not all, of this.
- 2. Notify those who may be interested in attending
 - a. Finalize the obituary. The funeral home will help you publish an obituary in local newspapers and online
 - b. Inform people of the service plans through phone calls, social media, and email
- 3. Arrange for transportation of family members to and from the services and any gatherings, if needed.
- 4. Finalize pre and post-service gatherings, if any, including location and catering
- 5. Book or suggest accommodations for out-of-town guests, if necessary
- 6. Personal touches
 - a. Memorial Table: Display personal items, photos, and mementos
 - b. Memory Book: Provide a guest book for attendees to sign and leave messages. The funeral home will have a book in several places for guests to sign. A memory book is an opportunity for them to leave messages.
 - c. Keepsakes: Consider offering small keepsakes or memory cards to guests
- 7. Obtain thank you notes/acknowledgments: The funeral home will likely do this for you. You may decide on the type, style, and wording
- 8. Additional tips
 - a. Do not hesitate to ask family and friends for assistance
 - b. Make decisions at a pace that feels comfortable for you
 - c. Remember to take care of yourself during this challenging time
 - d. Remember your pre-made plans and do not second-guess the decisions you made earlier
