

# Frame request to translate the IIF FAQs

The IIF Outreach Community Group would like to see key documentation translated into other languages. The rationale and the work process are more thoroughly defined in the [IIF Translation Task Force](#). As a test point, the frequently asked questions (FAQs) have been chosen to be first translated. Both FAQs can be found online:

In order to translate the IIF FAQs, here are the main steps to follow:

1. If not already done, **create a folder of the target language** (Spanish, French, Dutch, Japanese, etc.) in the IIF Translations Directory and/or ask the IIF Technical Coordinator to grant you write access to this folder
  - a. IIF Translations Directory:

2. **Make a copy** of the IIF FAQ and the IIF-C FAQ Google Documents and place them in the appropriate folder
  - a. IIF FAQ:

3. **Try to not format the document** by keeping the Markdown syntax (especially for the sections and the hyperlinks)
  - a. If you are not accustomed to Markdown, ask one of the Outreach Community Group Co-Chairs or someone familiar with this syntax to help you. [Here is a link](#) to a good Markdown Cheatsheet.
  - b. If the Markdown syntax is still too complicated, keep it as simple as possible and put the URLs in brackets or as comments
4. Once translated, ask someone who wasn't part of the translation process **to proofread the documents**
5. Once reviewed, reach out to the Outreach Group and **a pull request (PR)** will be done by one of the Outreach Community Group Co-Chairs
6. Once the PR accepted by the IIF Technical Coordinator, the translation will be **available on the iif.io website**
