Below is the Spring 2022 State of Michigan assessment scheduled for 10th-grade students. In conjunction with local assessments, these assessments provide information about student performance on Michigan's instructional standards for English Language Arts (ELA), Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies and are required by the State of Michigan. This information can then be used to deepen instructional practice within Meridian Early College High School.

All Assessments begin at 8:05 AM. Late arrivals will not be permitted to test. **Departure times below are subject to change.**

10th	PSAT 10	8:05AM-11:30AM; PSAT 10 is 2 hours and 55 minutes, with additional time needed for other test related items.

Following the completion of the PSAT 10, **students may leave if they have their own transportation on Wednesday, April 13.** Otherwise, students will report to the Commons to work on assignments until dismissal.

During the PSAT process, students have the option to participate in the PSAT Student Search Service that provides additional information regarding college planning options. To participate in this service, the attached consent form must be returned to MECHS Office no later than Wednesday, April 6.
