School Safety Presentation - Mr. Pascarelli

- monthly safety meetings & 12 emergency drills each school year (8 evacuations & 4 soft lockdowns)
- 4 Types of Drills
 - Hard Lockdown & Soft Lockdown "locks, lights, out of sight"
 - season starts in October
 - teachers will explain to students so you can ask your teacher for how they

present what is going to happen

- o Evacuation Drill fire drill
- Shelter In in building, business as usual, no one in or out of the building
- School Bus Drills 3 times a year
- Code Blue Team CPR & AED trained teachers and staff, surprise drills at least twice a year
- School Discipline and Behavior Intervention, for grades 6-12
- Discipline Code (two versions: K-5 and 6-12)
 - o progressive discipline uses incremental intervention, discipline response coupled with support and intervention
- De-Escalation & School Environment
 - o staff trained twice a year on de-escalation
 - therapeutic crisis intervention services (TCIS)
 - o the goal is never punishment but to correct student behavior for school learning
