

Talent Show 2022 Information

We're excited about your child/ren's participation in the 2022 Grant Talent Show. Following is important information. PLEASE READ!

COVID Protocols:

FOR THE PERFORMANCE:

- For the safety of our guests and performers, this year we are currently planning to hold the Talent Show performance on a stage in the Grant yard. If conditions permit, it may be moved to the Grant auditorium.
- Vaccination or proof of negative PCR test within 72 hours is required for all guests. Proof of vaccination or test result will be checked at entry as well as temperature check.
- Masks will be required at all times.

FOR ALL REHEARSALS AND PERFORMANCES:

- Students must have attended school that day and passed the COVID screening requirements for attending school and not be in isolation or quarantine.
- Rehearsal group assignment is TBD at this point and will take into account rules for cohort mixing at the time the rehearsals start.
- Masks will be required at all times.
- If your student will be playing an instrument, please provide proper PPE as required. (Email us if you need more details on this.)
- In the event of rain, rehearsals may be moved indoors or cancelled depending on the restrictions in place at the time.

GROUP ACTS:

At this point, groups are limited to participants within the same household or classroom. If cohort mixing is allowable closer to the date that rehearsals start, we will update this rule. UPDATE (3/1): Due to updated rules, this restriction is removed. Groups can be formed across households, classrooms, or grades without restriction.

GREAT IDEAS FOR TALENT SHOW ACTS:

Monologues, 2 person scenes, dances, magic, poetry reading, comedy, gymnastics, performance art, musicians, singing or anything else special you want to showcase (NO LIP-SYNCING)

PERFORMANCES

-Acts are 90 seconds long. No exceptions.

-If your child is in Elemental Strings, s/he is expected to come to talent show rehearsals. Those students will go first in rehearsals and be out with enough time to get to Elemental. They will need to miss Elemental for the Friday show.

-We need to account for all the students. You must make clear to us if:

*your child will come directly to us after school for rehearsal or after an enrichment or CREST class

*your child is getting picked up by someone other than you

*your child will report to Playground Access when done with rehearsal

*your child is absent and will miss rehearsal

*any situation that involves rehearsals and signing in and out

MUSIC

-If your act includes music please send us the file as soon as possible or by 3/6/22. Please email BOTH juliehoskin2002@yahoo.com and dsirh@mac.com

Please include:

- Either a YouTube link or hard file (mp3,wav, m4a, etc)

-Start and stop time for the music (If the timing is still being worked on, we still need the music for rehearsals so send it anyway and we can talk about timing later)

-Please be sure of your song choice the first time so there are no changes – we have limited rehearsals and editing time is valuable

-Singing Acts- YOU MUST USE KARAOKE VERSION in rehearsals and performance. Please DO NOT practice singing along with original artist.

-Clean language and age appropriate material only! Parents please review (and redirect if necessary) your child's selection early on so there are no issues down the road!

Participants must be practicing outside school. Rehearsal is for experience practicing in the actual venue.

PARENTS

-Please sign up to volunteer (at least once) at either a rehearsal or performance. We can't do it without you.

-Tickets will go on sale the week of the performances. More info to come.
