## **Requirements:**

- Use soft skills: Approachable, Friendly, Fun, & Welcoming
- Love God and have a deep passion for youth
- Show up to Commitments (Consistency is everything.)
- To minimize distractions in worship, we do not allow tank tops, shorts, or hats

**Key Responsibilities:** *The key responsibilities will be, but not limited to:* 

- Lead worship three of the four weeks every month (find guest worship leaders when needed)
- Work closely with youth pastor to understand goals for each service and prepare all areas of worship to accomplish those goals
- Provide up-front vocal and spiritual leadership for the band not just the administrative stuff, but a true heart for worship and seeing lives changed
- Provide charismatic leadership in creating environments of worship at a moment when it doesn't feel like it should be happening, transforming the room through music
- Manage weekly set lists in planning center, and assignment of vocalists, band, and youth production team
- Take guidance from youth pastor on weekly service flow, special events, etc.
- Setup tracks on prime app (ipad) weekly and assign someone in band to manage that each week
- Work with vocalists outside of sundays to prepare them harmonies, or just learning songs
- Bring new and vibrant worship songs to this group as needed
- Identify new potential band members and get them into training with adult leaders (dave/michael, etc)
- Stay up to date on slack for all of our communication as a team
- RSVP every week on planning center
- Provide adult supervision with safety & security for the youth
