In a stunning victory on the second attempt, longtime Dixie Republican Seldom won the Governor's mansion with a <u>+5.2 Margin</u>. Before the election, Seldom struck a partisan tone, painting a story of the Democratic party's inefficiency in running the state. The messaging stuck statewide, obviously. Yet, for local elections, the Assembly remained firmly in the hands of the Dixie Democratic Party. There is no surprise there. Dixie Republicans typically fail to swear into their seats and actually partake in the legislature. Take this term for example. Only <u>one</u> Assemblyperson for the Republican party has sworn in. The other <u>two</u> unsworn members were soundly ejected from the assembly for failure to vote or participate.

The Republicans faltering in the legislature has emboldened Assembly Speaker Scribba25 to wield decisive control over the legislative chamber.

He has made two tabling motions currently: One to table a <u>constitutional reform</u>, and another for a <u>personal education fund</u>.

When we reached out for comment, his office gave the following statement: "The reason for tabling is simple. The Constitutional reform bill is a gross attempt at overhauling the values already enshrined in the constitution. The Personal Education Fund has too much fluff to be functioning legislation. I will work with the Governor to get this issue fixed."

While the Scribba25-led Assembly has been hard at work passing Legislation, Seldom has been absent from the job. Four bills have come into law with full force without the signature of the Governor. This doesn't bode well for the narrative that the Democrats were inactive and ineffective when she herself is inactive and ineffective herself. The Governor has done nothing to assist with the fires burning near the Oklahoma Border with Superior nor has she done anything about militant forces building up in Dixie on both sides of the political spectrum.

Did Seldom tell the people of Dixie a lie? Are the Democrats in this alone?
