- The short version of Tradition One states: "Our common welfare comes first; personal recovery depends upon AA unity." Our group strives to create a safe meeting environment where alcoholics can focus on achieving sobriety.
- It is this group's group conscience that if any person endangers or disrupts the group's effort to carry the AA message, the chair/host may ask that person to leave the meeting.
- Here at Coffee and Donuts we follow Tradition Five: "Each group has but one primary purpose - to carry the message to alcoholics who still suffer."
