

HORNS WEAR & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Hello!

Thank you for purchasing my horns from Calcifer Curse!

This document is instructions on **How to Wear your Horns** & **How to Take Care of your Horns!**

How to wear:

Demon & Impling horns are on a **stretch cord!**

Each purchased pair of horns should receive a '**cord stopper**'.

The headband/stretch cord is meant to be worn around the head, like a headband. Having the tie sitting at the back/base of the head, *NOT* under the chin. (But you do what is more comfortable for you!)

Stretch cord is the same material to make stretch bracelets. If you need a longer cord or if it needs replacement, you can purchase it from a craft store. My cord is "**0.8 mm**"

If you purchase my horns at a convention and the cord is too short, please return to my booth and I will provide you with a new one!

This cord stopper is a more comfortable and sturdy way to 'tie' the horns on. I believe it's more comfortable and helps extend the longevity of the stretch cord.

You may tie the stretch cord but if you do not knot it properly, it can unravel as the material is slick.

If you need a replacement cord stopper, you may also purchase it from a craft store. It may be in the "notions" section.

How to use the cord stopper:

- Grab both ends of your cord.
- Squeeze down on the top of the cord stopper, creating the hole/opening.
- Thread both cord ends into the opening and pull through.
- Once you let go of the cord stopper, it will stop the cord in place.



Both cords ends should be threaded through the hole after you squeeze down on the cord stopper.



This should be the end result after threading the cord through

Recommendations on how to put on your horns:

- Thread & tighten your cord stopper to a point that's loosen enough to put on your head but not too tight either.
 - Make sure the horns are pointing the correct direction. They should be pointing towards you.
 - Once you have the stretch cord on, tighten the cord until it is comfortable, then move the horns in place.
 - Once you have the horns in place where you want them, tighten the cord once again
 - Keep repeating until you're satisfied with the placement of the horns.
- If you have a second pair of hands to assist you, I recommend you hold the horns in place where you want them to sit, then the second person helps you tighten the cord from behind.
- If you have long hair, have a hair tie or claw clip to hold your hair up while you put on your horns.
- If you are going to wear your horns more on your forehead, I recommend a skin safe adhesive such as Spirit Gum, Pros-aide, or eyelash glue. (Please read instructions & ingredients and use at your own risk)

How to Take Care of your Horns

For All Horns

Please store horns in a room/cool temperature.

High heat and high humidity will cause resin to warp.

Please do not leave them out in the sun, as it will cause the resin to warp.

To clean; use cold water and soap, towel dry.

Hot water will cause the resin to warp.

For UV horns

Charge the horns under sunlight or under a blacklight.

DO NOT keep it in direct heat for too long and it will cause it to warp.

Please try not to drop your horns

I have done plenty of drop tests and they are resilient, but they have a limit as well.

The first place to snap is the tip of the horn, so please be careful.

You can fix it with a *super glue*, if you use a hot glue gun, it will warp the resin.
