Treasurer	• Manages the financial accounts and budgeting for the chapter as part of the Administration team .	Open to all MBBS students.
Design Officer	• Designing promotional materials for social media as well as physical events (e.g. lanyards, banners, etc.) . • Designs merchandises (e.g. t-shirts, tote bags, pins, etc.) .	Open to all MBBS students.
Publicity Officer	• Manages the club's social media (Instagram @amsa.newcastle) . • Promotes the club and its events to increase public awareness . • Creates publicity strategies to increase club visibility .	Open to all MBBS students.

AMSEP Officer	- Leads the AMSA Exchange Program (if any) . - Manages communications with other AMSA chapters . - Represents AMSA Newcastle in external collaborations .	Open to all MBBS students. <i>(Student should be able to commit physically in Johor during summer break)</i>
Pre-clinical Academic Officer	Planning, managing and executing pre-clinical related events	Open to Year 1 and Year 2 MBBS students.
Clinical Academic Officer	- Planning, managing and executing academically related events . - Event Leads for USMLE and OSCE tutorials, skills seminars/ workshops (ECG, anatomy, etc.) .	Open to Year 3 to Year 5 MBBS students.
Public Health Officer	- Planning, managing and executing public health related events . - Event Leads for volunteer events (Kechara Soup Kitchen, Old Folk's Home visit, etc.) .	Open to all MBBS students.
Research & Scientific Officer	- Planning, managing and executing clinical skills related events . - Promoting and facilitating research activities (e.g. Medical Research Round Table Talk, etc.) .	Open to all MBBS students.
