

Wolf-Tones Boosters Meeting Minutes

Welcome and introductions (roll call for minutes)

Approval of Prior Meeting Minutes - Prior meeting minutes (November); motion for approval (Jaime), seconded (Jennifer). Meeting minutes passed.

Student Leadership Update: Natalie and Max

- Collected items, for the silent auction, need to be picked up. 11 items were collected by student reps
- Note for next year, would be better to request donations earlier (suggested August)

Treasurer's Update:

- \$12k paid in November, largest monthly bulk of costs
- So far finances are break even. Nearly all of the funding that has been received so far this year has gone into covering invoices that have already come in
- Su requested emails to be sent in advance before items are purchased or Brant to copy Su when an order is placed, especially for large invoices (over ~\$2500?), so that they can be planned for and Su can gather all of the necessary information to understand which accounts to charge

Director's Report: Brant

- Request for funds to cover honor band audition fees: motion by Jaime to grant up to \$2k for honor band audition fees, seconded by Hina, motion passed
- Concert attire: Need to communicate with parents next year that concert attire needs to be ordered at the deadline, so Wolf-Tones does not need to pay for rushing orders for those who missed the deadline
- Need to rethink how donations are requested, especially considering that this year marching band donations were very light and are not covering costs sufficiently

- Discussion on uniforms, need to communicate need for donations to ensure sufficient funding, and request returning uniforms from graduating seniors
- Winter concert Thursday, December 11

Old Business:

- See's fundraiser: \$1800 net profit; discussion point for early next fall, if next year we should just do online sales as the percentages are similar and pre-sale is a lot of extra effort
- Ski Swap: still need many volunteers to sign up on sign up genius. Thanks to Dan for all of the hard work organizing this big event!
- Dan requested that Brant help ensure the big gate is open around 3 pm to drive the truck onsite with all of the ski donations
- Winter concert: Hina and Brant will check on some front of house logistics for the concert
