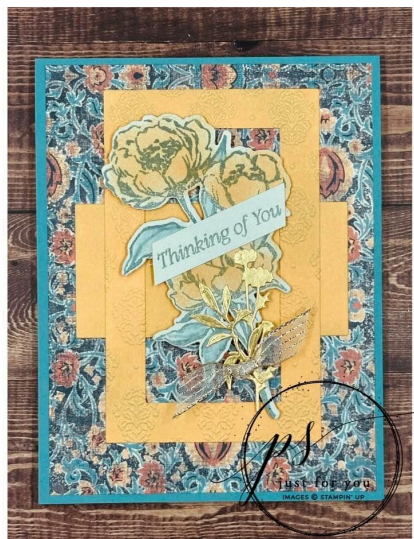

Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Gallery Blooms Stamp Set (165211); Beautiful Motifs Stamp Set (165198)
- **Card Stock** – Beautiful Gallery Designer Series Paper (DSP (165196)); Basic Beige Card Stock (164511); Lost Lagoon Card Stock (133679); Peach Pie Card Stock (163799); Gold Foil Sheets (132622)
- **Stamp Pads** – Lost Lagoon Classic Stampin' Pad (161678); Peach Pie Classic Stampin' Pad (163810); Basic Beige Classic Stampin' Pad (163806)
- **Misc.** – Blender Pens (102845); Gallery Blooms Dies (165212); Dimensionals (104430); Sponge Daubers (133773); Gold Striped 3/8" Mesh Ribbon (165599); Damask Designs Embossing Folder (165214); Mini Glue Dots (103683); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Paper Trimmer (152392); Paper Snips (103579); Blending Brushes (153611)

Measurements:

- Lost Lagoon Card Stock: 4¼" x 11"
- Peach Pie Card Stock: 4¼" x 5½"
- Basic Beige Card Stock: 4" x 5¼" and some scrap pieces for die cutting and greeting
- Beautiful Gallery DSP: 4" x 5¼"

Instructions:

1. Using paper trimmer cut lost lagoon cardstock to 4¼" x 11", then score at 5½".
2. Attach designer series paper using liquid glue.
3. Stamp the flower on basic beige scrap in lost lagoon ink. Using sponge daubers, color the flower petals with peach pie ink. Using blender pens color the leaves of the flower.
4. Stamp the greeting on a ½" scrap piece of basic beige.
5. Using machine die cut peach pie cardstock with the rectangle die. You will not use the outside rectangle of the three that were die cut. Also, die cut the flower. Die cut the smaller pieces from the gold sheets as shown. Then run the peach pie piece thru the damask designs embossing folder.

6. Using a blending brush add basic beige ink to the two peach pie rectangles. Attach the two peach pie rectangles with liquid glue as shown in picture.
7. Attach the flower to the card as shown using dimensional.
8. Add the two gold die cuts to the flower with liquid glue.
9. Tie the ribbon in a knot and trim the ends. Attach with a glue dot.
10. Stamp the greeting on a $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip of basic beige cardstock. Trim the ends with snips. Attach with liquid glue at a slant on the focal point flower.
11. Lastly, stamp the flower in lost lagoon ink one more time on the basic beige piece that is 4" x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " in the lower lefthand corner letting half of it stamp off so only the three flowers at the top show. Color the same as the one on the front focal piece. Attach to the inside of the card.
