General Meeting

1. Call to order - The meeting was called to order by Chair Taylor at 6:43 pm.
2. Welcome and introductory remarks - Chair Taylor welcomed and introduced guests Marquis Mason from the Oregon League of Conservation Voters and Madison Daisy from Renew Oregon.
3. Approval of minutes - Steve Harbert moved to approve the minutes as presented and Stephanie Schlitzkus seconded the motion. Motion passed by unanimous vote of all Precinct Committee People (PCP) present.

Clean Energy Jobs Presentation

A number of House Bills were presented and explained:

HB 2007 requires upgrades to diesel trucks, using funds from the VW lawsuit.

HB 2209 puts restrictions on oil trains and provides funds for clean up of spills.

HB 2619 and 2058 bans certain pesticides. Support from rural Democrats is especially important on both these bills.

HB 3132 stops the building of more dams.

HB 2020A is the Clean Energy Jobs bill, which includes a cap and invest action. The investment breakdown is 10% to tribes, 40% to historically marginalized communities and 50% to new green technologies. Madison Daisy asked that those present keep the pressure on state legislators by calling them weekly.
