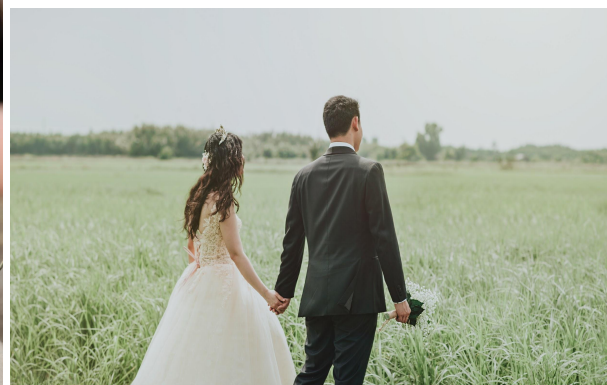
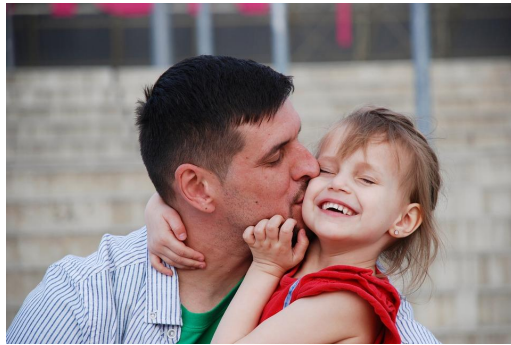


1. Different manifestation of love



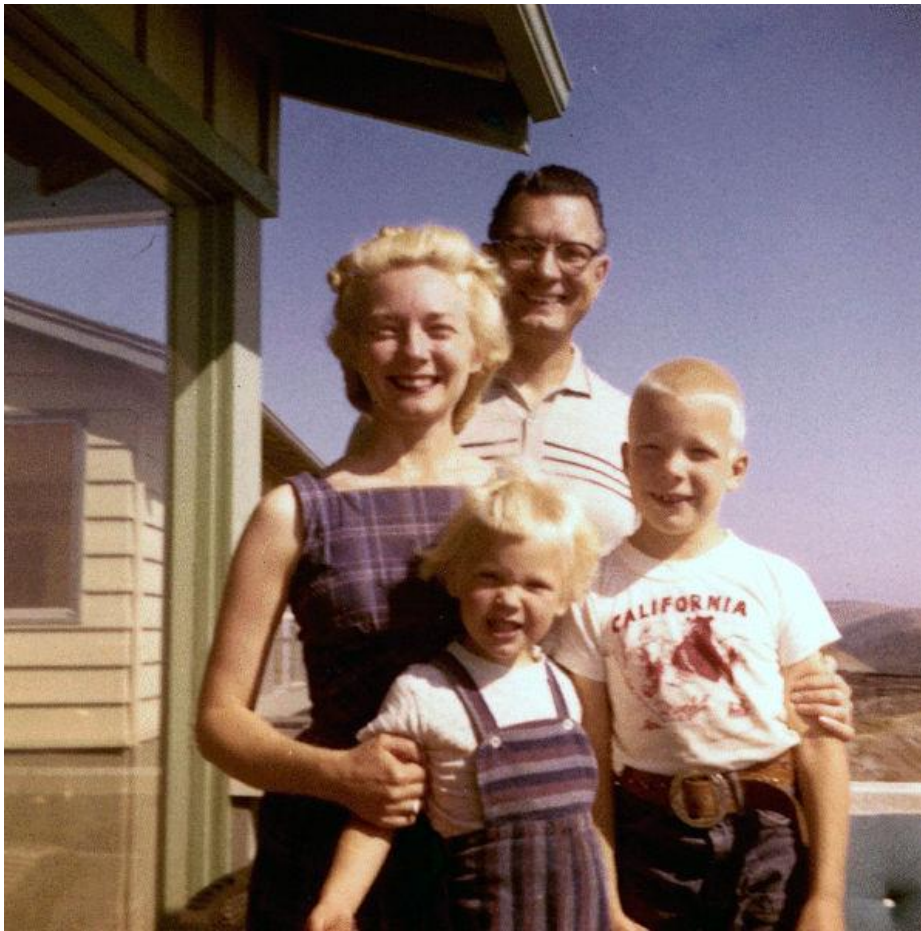
Name	Thoughts

2. Big and small families





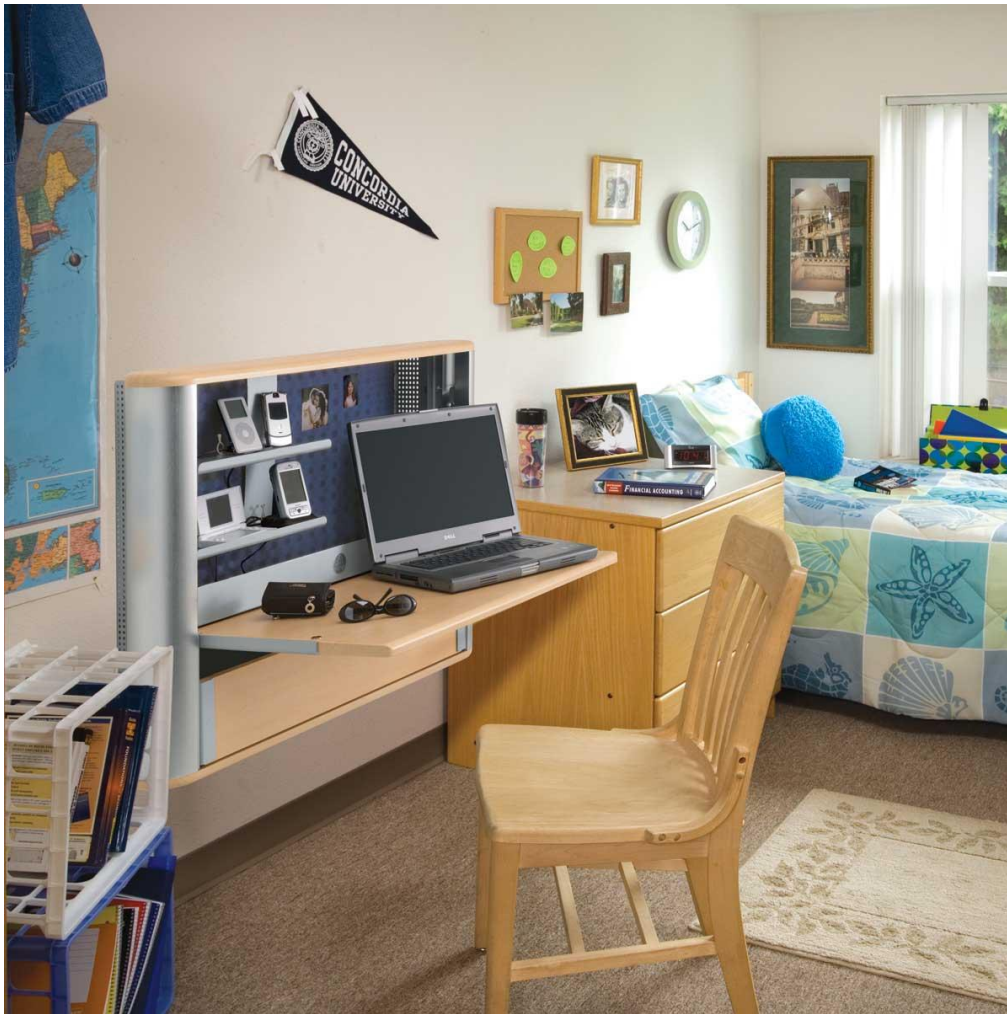
