The Internet has led to the affirmation of electronic games as a sport branch, as electronic sport. In 1980, Atari Co. held the first competition of this kind, the Space Invaders Tournament, with over 10,000 participants. The Competitions have evolved and diversified, rising to the professional level.

There are several types of games:

- Fighting games : the Mortal Kombat, Street Fighters Series
- Games with real time strategy: StarCraft, Warcraft III, Starcraft II
- First person shooter games : CounterStrike
- Sporting games: FIFA Football, TrackMania Nations Forever

The most popular competitions take place within the World e-Sports and Electronic World Cup. On an international level, there are bodies that govern the branch of electronic games. The governing authority is the International eSports Federation, founded in Seoul, Korea, on August 11, 2008, in which Romania is also a member.

The development of sport on an industrial level has occurred through the improvement and rapidity of communication through all the means involved in the field, the virtual space, the internet, having a major role.

The development of a real sporting industry, with massif extension and diversification not only in the field of sports, but in that of its economic component also, has led to the necessity of developing an efficient communication strategy that should maintain a permanent link with fans, through all the means of communication that can be involved in this process. The consequences have established a vital role for communication in sports management, through the elaboration of adequate strategies, through an unprecedented promotion of sporting products and services, through the formation of a complex sport culture and through a high-speed informational flow. Communication determines the continuous development of the sport industry and has established new sport branches, that of e-sports.

- 1. **Affirmation** The action of confirming or establishing something as true or recognized; in this case, acknowledging electronic games as a legitimate branch of sports.
- 2. **Competition** An organized event in which people or teams compete against each other to win.

- 3. **Diversified** To have increased the variety of something; in this text, it refers to how electronic games have developed into different types and genres.
- 4. **Governing** Being in charge or having control over something; for example, a body that manages and regulates electronic sports.
- 5. **Authority** An organization or person with official power to make decisions and control activities.
- 6. **Federation** A group of states or organizations that are united in some way; here, it refers to an organization that oversees e-sports globally.
- 7. **Industrial** Relating to industry or large-scale production, often focused on business and economic growth.
- 8. **Strategy** A detailed plan for achieving success in a particular area, like communication in sports management.
- 9. **Promotion** Activities or efforts made to increase interest or awareness of something, such as sports products or events.
- 10. **Informational** Relating to information or the communication of data and knowledge, often to keep people informed.
