

Franklin Central Band Boosters Application for Senior Scholarships

This application prepared for **Senior Class of 2024**

These scholarships are sponsored by the Franklin Central Band Boosters in memory of Christa Hillebrand, Steve Kawalek, and Raymond Hauser, and in honor of Daniel Fyffe. Christa and Steve are former band members who were tragically killed in accidents in 1990 and 1996, respectively. Mr. Hauser is an esteemed former director of the Franklin Central Bands program. Mr. Fyffe is also an esteemed former director of the Franklin Central Bands program, as well as a former director within the Franklin Twp. Schools. The attached form should be used to apply for all scholarships.

1. The scholarships are to be awarded annually in the amount of at least \$500 each. (Amounts may be increased at the sole discretion of the Franklin Central Band Boosters Board.)
2. The scholarship committee shall consist of the Franklin Central Band Boosters Board, which includes elected officers, directors, and liaisons. If an applicant is related to a Board member, that board member shall not participate in the selection process.
3. The scholarship shall be awarded to a Franklin Central High School student who has at least a "C" average, who has completed seven (7) semesters of band/guard with a "C" average or better, and who has been accepted by a college or vocational school for post high school studies.
4. The name of the scholarship recipients will be announced at the Spring Concert held in May.
5. **The letters and essay MUST BE TYPED**, and attached to the neatly filled out application pages.
- 6. Applications and accompanying documents must be emailed to FCBB_Board@fcbands.org no later than 11:59pm on Sunday, May 5, 2024. Applications received without all requested information may be disregarded.**

Please submit with your completed application:

1. One supporting letter from a teacher, counselor, or principal.
2. A copy of your high school transcript.

Applications that do not include all requested information may not be considered during the selection process.
