About the Junior School Food Services Program

What does participation in the JS Food Services Program look like?

- Participation is optional for all families in JK to Grade 6.
- There is no option to participate on select days only.
- Sign-up is by term and cost is based on the number of school days in the term. This will be charged to your account. Please note that there is NO option to register for select-days only.
- The terms are as follows:
 - Fall (September to December)
 - Winter (January to March)
 - Spring (March to June)

What kinds of foods will be provided?

- Grade 1 to 6 students will be able to choose from a wide variety of foods in the Servery, including hot entrees, soups, sandwiches, salad bar and fresh fruit; please take a moment to review the [JS Fall Menu](#).
- JK and SK students will have the choice of either a meat entree or a vegetarian “entree of the day,” dessert and milk, delivered to their class.
- The Chartwells’ Team and our teachers will be on hand to support all of our students in making well-balanced choices.
- There will be alternatives available every day (made-without gluten, made-without dairy, vegan, etc.).

What accommodations are there for students with allergies or other dietary restrictions?

- We are able to accommodate students with food allergies and dietary restrictions by having our chef prepare their meals separately and individually, carefully labeled with their names. These alternative meal options will be as close to the regular meal as possible (eg. instead of plain pasta, it will be made-without gluten pasta).
- We strongly encourage parents who have questions or concerns to contact ChartwellsFood@havergal.on.ca. Please note that we are an allergen-aware facility, which means that cross contaminations may occur.

Where will the children eat?

- Students in JK and SK will be served lunch in their classrooms.
- Students in Grades 1–6 will eat in the dining hall.

What happens if my child does NOT participate in the JS Food Services Program?

- Should your child not participate, they should bring a litterless lunch from home, which they can also enjoy eating in the dining hall.

What is the cost for the fall term (September to December)?

- JK–SK: \$603.00
- Grade 1–3: \$619.75
- Grade 4–6: \$720.25

How do I register my child?

- Please complete [JS Food Services Registration Form](#). This form will close on Friday, September 16, 2022.
- Please also note the following:
 - If you have registered for the Food Services Program, you may “opt-out” no later than Thursday, October 6, to receive a refund for the remainder of the term. You may not “opt-out” beyond this date, nor receive a refund beyond this date.
 - Families are, however, permitted to register later in the term, and you will be charged a prorated fee instead of the full fee.
