In 2009, their son, Ryan, was diagnosed with Spinal Muscular Atrophy Type I when he was 3 months old. He lived to celebrate his 6 month birthday with his parents and family and then passed away in their arms early the next day on July 28th, 2009. His life was brief, but what he has left behind is a legacy of love and the desire in his parent's hearts to help other individuals with muscle diseases.

While Ryan was very young when he passed, the Hawn's remain inspired by the individuals and families that live with the challenges of living with a muscle disease every day. For this reason, we would like to support graduating seniors as they enter the next chapter of their lives and help them with the expenses that come with the pursuit of education beyond high-school. - 4. One letter of recommendation from a teacher or mentor.
