CONCERT ATTENDANCE

Attendance is required at all concerts.

Excused Concert Absences include a death in the family, religious observance, emergency or illness. If a student is unable to attend the concert, please inform your music teacher of your situation as soon as possible.

<u>Unexcused Concert Absences</u> may affect eligibility for future performances. Unexcused absences include, but are not limited to, sports conflicts, social events, family birthdays, or failure to remember. A make-up assignment may be required.

If there is a problem with transportation, we want to help you. Let us know and every effort will be made to facilitate participation.

If you are in <u>both</u>, go to band on Tuesday and chorus on Thursday.

All students are encouraged to participate in both band and chorus.

REHEARSAL ATTENDANCE

A student is expected to attend all scheduled rehearsals of their performing group. This includes rehearsals that meet before school at 7:30, during the school day, or after school.

Excused Absences include absences from school, appointments, field trips, using a FREE PASS (this will be explained in rehearsal.)

<u>Unexcused Absences</u> must be made up in order to participate in the pending concert. *Unexcused absences during blackout cannot be made up and will result in a student losing performance privileges.* Please contact your music teacher if extenuating circumstances arise.

<u>Blackout</u> is a short period of rehearsal time before the performance, including dress rehearsal. Free passes cannot be used during this time. Details will be provided in rehearsal.
