Welcome to Mannion Middle School Summer Enrichment & Credit Retrieval! We are excited to have your student join us for summer learning! We put together some updates and reminders regarding policies and procedures to alleviate confusion and concerns. Please take a few minutes to review the information. Masks (Effective June 1, 2021):

1. All staff who are fully vaccinated are not required to wear a mask on District sites. School busses are the exception - masks must be worn on busses by staff members.
2. Masks are optional for students in Grades 6 through 12 who have been fully vaccinated. School busses are the exception - masks must be worn on busses by students
3. Students and staff who are outside, regardless of their vaccination status, do not have to wear a mask.
4. The State of Nevada has not mandated that students provide proof of COVID-19 vaccinations.

Summer Bell Schedule:

The Summer Bell Schedule is as follows:

The cafeteria will be open for student breakfast at 7:30 AM. Students will be supervised in the cafeteria from between 7:30 AM and 8:00. Students not having breakfast will not be permitted on campus until 7:45 AM. Students may use the bike rack or be dropped off in front of the school. Students utilizing CCSD transportation will be dropped off behind the school.

Students who leave at the end of a session will be permitted to leave campus and walk home or meet their ride. Students leaving early will be required to leave campus.

If a student needs to be picked up early for an appointment, parents must enter the main office and show proper identification prior to the student being released.

In the event a parent needs to drop off an item, drop offs must be left at the main office.

Dress Code & School Policies:

To ensure an appropriate learning environment, CCSD dress code and all other school policies will be enforced. Students participating in outside activities are permitted to wear hats and sunscreen should be applied.

Lunch & Student Store:

CCSD will provide free lunch to all participants. Students may also bring lunch, but there is no place for the lunch to be stored. It will have to remain with the student for the entire time on campus.

Drinks and snacks will be sold in the student store for \$1. We will ask the students to share preferences for drinks and snacks and shop accordingly.
