From greeting voters at the polls to conducting phone banking efforts, our coalition has worked tirelessly to encourage Pennsylvanians to write in "Uncommitted" as a powerful statement of dissent and demand for change.

"We have been overwhelmed by the enthusiasm and dedication of our volunteers who have engaged directly with voters today, either at the polls or through phone and textanking," remarked Uncommitted PA organizer Shalah Ramadan. "Today's efforts are a testament to the growing support for the Uncommitted anti-war movement in the United States and growing desire for meaningful action by our President to change course in Gaza."

Volunteers on the ground have echoed similar sentiments about the experience of engaging with voters and advocating for the "Uncommitted" write-in for President.

"I think that the uncommitted vote forces Biden to see. It's we who feel so helpless and so powerless during all of this. But voting uncommitted is a small thing and we'll do whatever small thing there is," said Joanna L, volunteering at a polling location in Philadelphia.

Uncommitted PA will be tracking the election results closely and will provide updates to the public via social media and press releases as they become available. Every write-in vote contributes to our collective voice demanding change and accountability.
