She is active and curious student and confidently puts her question and thoughts during her class in school. she has been evolving in every orientation, trainings and workshops on school related gender based violence, mensural hygiene, about disability, child marriage, importance of education. She participated actively in every events in school by project. She also shares with other student about those topics. She confidently gives her introductions and interact new people without any hesitation. Her class teachers also said , the girls form Saliya Khan and herself is very proactive in class, participate in every activities in class."
