- 1. Manage school operations and resources to promote each student's academic success and well-being. (District Goal A) -- ISSL Standard #9
 - a. Possible Indicators of Progress
 - i. We will maintain an Unspent Balance of 10% of total budget.
 - ii. We will maintain a Fund Balance of 8% of total general fund expenditures.
 - iii. We will maintain a balanced budget
 - b. Board Indicator of Support:
 - i. Board will support financial recommendations to allow us to maintain and establish possible indicators of progress
- 2. Cultivate an inclusive, caring, and supportive school community that promotes the academic success and well-being of each student. (District Goal B, C, D) -- ISSL Standard #5
 - a. Possible Indicators of Progress
 - i. Ensures accountability systems are implemented to build and maintain a safe, caring, and healthy school environment that meets the academic, social, emotional, and physical needs of each student.
 - ii. Empowers and expects staff to make adjustments to academic and emotional supports based upon evaluations of multiple sources of data.
 - iii. Models adult-adult, adult-student, student-peer, and school-community relationships that value and support academic learning and positive social and emotional development.
 - b. Board Indicator of Support:
 - i. Board will take recommendations and allocate appropriate resources toward inspiring each learning, improving facilities, grounds and technology.
 - ii. Board will put students first in approving staffing recommendations.
- 3. Develop and support intellectually rigorous and coherent systems of curriculum, instruction, and assessment to promote each student's academic success and well-being. (District Goal C, D) -- ISSL Standard #4
 - a. Possible Indicators of Progress
 - i. Regularly engages the school board in discussions about curriculum, instruction, and assessment to ensure that policy is aligned with current practices.
 - ii. Routinely dialogues with the School Improvement Advisory Committee, families and other stakeholders to inform decisions regarding curriculum, instruction, and assessment.
 - iii. Reviews system resources in collaboration with school and district leaders to ensure equitable allocation based upon student needs.
 - b. Board Indicator of Support:
 - i. The Board will hear reports on student needs and achievements
 - ii. The Board will direct resources (time and dollars) toward selected staff development which addresses identified district needs.
 - iii. The board will advocate within the community regarding the importance of support for staff development.
 - iv. The Board will hear reports back about the effectiveness of staff development efforts.
