Terms of Service

General

- I reserve the right to refuse a commission for any reason.
- I am comfortable drawing nearly anything, but I have my strengths and weaknesses. Strengths would include organic creatures, such as humans, aliens, monsters, anthro, animals, etc., whereas I have a difficult time drawing more inorganic forms like robots, vehicles, furniture, weaponry, etc.
- I communicate through all mediums, either via note on FurAffinity, deviantART, Weasyl
 or asks/submissions/fanmail through Tumblr, BUT it would be much more simple to send
 me e-mails at dendropsyche@gmail.com
- Please keep contact through one account/email! I very easily get confused if someone tries contacting me via multiple mediums and names.
- The commissioner is responsible for providing me with all the information needed to complete the commission.
- I have only 2 days out of my week to work on commissions (Wednesday and Thursday), and while you may poke a reminder at me (because I am prone to forget), please do not rush me. I do not do deadlines.
- I may rarely work on commissions on my Work days, however I am a massage therapist 5 days out of the week, so I find fine motor movements difficult after a day of massage.
- I reserve the right to post my artwork anywhere--if you wish, I can leave a big fat watermark on it to prevent theft, but I would prefer not to.
- If the client is under the age of 18 (a minor in the United States), do not solicit me for NSFW pieces. I could get into some serious legal trouble and I do not want that.
- If you would like me to create a NSFW piece for you, please be ready to show your proof of age in the form of a license or other official document (and feel free to censor out any sensitive information, such as your address!).
- If the piece you want to commission includes characters that do not belong to you, please ask the owners of the characters to contact me to express that I have permission to use them in my artwork.

Payment, plans and refunds

- Full payment is due up-front before I begin working (I'll typically send you some examples/rough sketches of your potential commission beforehand though, because I'm REALLY NICE--abuse this and I may have to start charging)
- PAYPAL ONLY. Please send me your PayPal address so that I can send you an invoice.

- I may also accept Amazon gift cards if I know you very well, and if there is some level of trust between us considering that gift cards are not refundable. Please ask me before you attempt paying in this form!
- I take USD only, so other currencies will have to be converted.
- For pieces costing \$100 and above, I accept payment plans of a \$50 minimum installments.
- I will begin work once the entire payment is made.
- If I cannot finish your commission for any reason after you have paid, I will refund you in full.
- I reserve the right to cancel your commission at any time for any reason, and will refund you completely.
- The commissioner also reserves the right to cancel the commission at any time for any reason for a refund.
- If the cancellation is in the case of personal matters, you will be refunded in full.
- If the cancellation is in the case of commissioner misconduct on cancellation on the commissioner's part, you will be refunded for the work not yet done. (If no work has been done, you receive a full refund. If partial work has been done, you will receive a partial refund, minus the amount for the work done)
 - If you are simply unsatisfied with the work, I will only charge what I have worked on so far, and refund the rest.
- No refunds are available once the work is complete.

Progress, Edits, Alterations, etc.

- I will continually update you through our main form of communication each stage of the commission, from base sketch, to a more cleaned and "final" sketch, to the inks, flat colors, shading, and background (if requested). I will not continue with the commission until you have approved each stage.
- I typically do not ask for compensation when making edits or alterations, but I will make an exception if the edit is large enough (such as changing a large part of the pose when I am already in inks/colors/etc.). If it's a mistake on my part, though, the alteration will be free.
- Though I have slots on my commission queue, they don't necessarily mean that the first slot is "first in line"--they mainly mean who contacted me first. I work on each commission based on who responds to my updates earlier, which stages I can tackle when I am working, etc.. Having the first slot does not guarantee your commission will be finished before the others!
- Please understand that I do have a life outside of the internet, and a job outside of commissions--these often will impede my ability to work on art, but they mainly pay my bills!

Rights

Commissioner

- You are free to post any commission done for you to a personal/public gallery, so long as credit is provided.
- You may make avatars, banners and other web graphics out of the art you receive
- If you or someone else finished it please credit me in the description
- Feel free to make prints/copies of the image so long as it is for personal use and no profit is made.
- You may not make NFTs out of the art you receive, or any other artworks I create.

Artist

- I reserve the right to refuse any commission for any reason, and am in no way obligated to provide a reason in the case of refusal.
- Unless I have explicitly stated otherwise, I will retain all copyright to my artwork, even when characters contained within the work belong to the commissioner. It is in my right

to post, distribute, copy, reproduce, etc for promotion. Which includes prints/etc to be sold at conventions (though it's highly unlikely that I ever will)

- I am not obligated to post your commission to my gallery, or anywhere else.
- I reserve the right to use rejected sketches (i.e. if you rejected a sketch for a whole new pose) for my own use, but I will alter it so the character doesn't look like yours.
