- If for some reason your plans change and you cannot volunteer, please advise the contact person for the event. Typically, Volunteer Coordinators assign students to specific jobs which will need to be filled and they usually have a waiting list or will need to reassign jobs.
- If you need a signed service form, you can bring one or you will receive one from the supervisor of that event at the end of your shift. (NHS, please bring your forms)
 - Unless specified, all opportunities are open to all students and adults
- Occasionally some organizations require applications or signed waivers. Please make sure you complete what's required of you. Failure to do so may result in a

lost volunteer opportunity.
