- God 'Bless The Child
- Jordu

Long black socks for your black dress shoes, black dress shirt
(collared/button-up), black slacks or long-full black skirt.

LADIES, you are welcome to wear a black blouse in lieu of a dress shirt. If your blouse has a lot of shoulder or neck, you are also free to wear a cardigan to help dress it up a little.

Don't forget to bring a plan for lunch - either a brown bag or \$\$ for the food-court.

THINGS WE DON'T WANT FOR CONCERT CLOTHES:

Black jeans

Black tennis shoes - or any tennis shoes

White socks

T Shirts, long sleeved t shirts

(remember you are under the lights, and you sit at eye level of the audience)
