FAO: 2nd Quarter Virtual/In-Person Learning Plan

Learning & Instruction

- 25% of the student enrollment participates virtually in the classroom one day a week (assigned by the first letter of last name).
- In this learning model, teachers will continue to provide synchronous instruction on a virtual platform (ZOOM / Google Meet) to the students on campus and those learning remotely.
- Students should bring a pair of headphones that can connect to their Chromebook. Extra headphones will be available in the dean's office.
- Students will participate remotely on days they are not assigned to be on campus for in-person learning.
- If the District is closed due to a school holiday, the all-remote day will be eliminated, and each student group will get their in-person day.
- The 100% remote day may be synchronous or asynchronous based on the individual teacher and that specific class period.
- TENTATIVE: The week of November 9th, transition to 50% of the student enrollment on campus based on last names.

Special Education

- Students receiving special education services will be contacted individually by your student's Case Manager as to their individual in-person and remote learning plans.
- Related services will continue to be provided by LADSE and RB service staff per each student's Individual Education Plan.

Logistics

- Students committed to in-person learning must stay the entire time.
- Students who have an early release period on their schedule are to leave the building following the end of 6th hour. Students who do not have an early release will be required to attend their entire schedule periods 1-7.
- Student attendance will continue to be taken online. If a student will be absent or to report an early release of a student, please call 708-442-7500 Ext: 2191.
- Lunches will be a grab and go. Snacking or eating lunch is not allowed in the building unless there is a medical exemption.
- Lockers will not be used.

Health and Safety

- If a student is sick or exhibiting any COVID-19 related symptoms they should stay home and participate remotely.
- Masks will be required for everyone inside the building (face masks with valves are not allowed).
- The <u>RAPTOR</u> Self-Certification email form must be completed by parents daily prior to their student attending school.
- Every student will go through a daily temperature screening prior to entering school.
- Students must wear and present their ID upon arrival on campus.
- Desks will be 6-feet apart when possible.
- Hand-sanitizer and disinfectant wipes have been placed in high-traffic areas including in all classrooms and common areas.
- Stairways have been marked with directional arrows.
- Hallway floors will be marked to keep traffic flowing to one side.
- Students should not be congregating in the hallway or in common areas during passing periods or at dismissal.
- Students and staff will adhere to social distancing expectations (6 ft apart) in and outside of the building when possible.
- Water fountains will be shut off however, water bottle refill stations will be available for students.
