

# Everyday Arches Dies

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## Supplies:

- Stamp Sets: Label Me Grateful (166108)
- Cardstock & Paper: Cherry Cobbler (119685), Crumb Cake (120953), Basic White (166780), Christmas Tags & More 6" x 6" Mix & Match Specialty Designer Series Paper or "DSP" (165907)
- Ink: Cherry Cobbler (147083)
- Miscellaneous: Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653), Paper Trimmer (152392), Everyday Arches Dies (164629), Textured Notes Dies (165555), Garden Green 1/8" Chevron Ribbon (167212), Rhinestone Basic Jewels (144220), Cherry Cobbler Stampin' Blends Combo Pack (154880), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), Multipurpose Liquid Glue or "glue" (110755), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Bone Folder (102300), scissors



## Measurements:

- Crumb Cake: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4", folded, and burnished with the Bone Folder
- Cherry Cobbler: 4" x 5-1/4", 3-1/2" x 5"
- Christmas Tags DSP: 3-7/8" x 5-1/8", the whole 6: x 6" sheet with ornaments
- Basic White: 1-1/4" x 2-1/2"
- Ribbon: 10"

## Instructions:

1. Glue background DSP to Cherry Cobbler with glue then adhere that piece to Crumb Cake card front.
2. Using the 4<sup>th</sup> from the largest Everyday Arches die, position the die so it is at the bottom of the centered red ornament and cut. Set aside Crumb Cake leftover piece.
3. Use the 3<sup>rd</sup> from the largest arch die to cut out the Cherry Cobbler layer. Glue the DSP to the Cherry Cobbler.
4. Stamp Thank You in Cherry Cobbler on Basic White and die cut with a rectangle from the Textured Notes Dies. From the same die set, cut the Crumb Cake polka dot leftover DSP piece. Cut the DSP so it's shorter and add to back of sentiment with glue. It should stick out 1/4" on each side.
5. Add ornament focal piece to card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Tie ribbon into a bow and add with one Mini Glue Dot.
7. With Stampin' Dimensionals add sentiment piece.
8. Color three rhinestones with the Cherry Cobbler Light Stampin' Blends then add to card front.
