Reformation of the Cuban Political System

Comrades of the glorious Republic,

The time has come for change within the Republic, our revival is coming - and quickly. I am releasing this statement today to inform you of the upcoming changes the Republic shall receive for its survival. As of today, I am declaring myself Caudillo of the Republic, and therefore supreme head of state of our glorious nation. I do not do this without support - with the Revolutionary Armed Forces, those who have protected us from international terrorists continuously: and the group managers providing their support for the re-establishment of the Caudillo. This move is big and done simply for the survival of our nation. We have done well in the international community under my administration, and we have gained a steady growth of members - alongside a good income from sales.
