

Scholars Program Alert: Now Accepting Applications

The Dr. Robert A. Scott Memorial Scholars Program sponsored by Beta Pi Boule of Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity and Beta Pi Boule, Inc., is now accepting applications for college scholarships worth \$3,000.

To apply, a student must:

- Be an African American male.
- Have earned at least a 3.0 grade average or equivalent in high school.
- Be engaged in community service and/or extracurricular activities.
- Be accepted for admission to an accredited college or university.
- Plan to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited college or university for the entire current academic year.
- Agree to participate in an annual Scholars Program event and/or ongoing communication with the Boulé.

Upper Class Assistance Program

The Dr. Robert A. Scott Memorial Scholarship is a one-time only award; however, college students who received the award as a graduating high school senior, may re-apply competitively, through our Upper-Class Assistance Program, for a scholarship amount based on available funding, for up to three additional years or until completion of a bachelor's degree (whichever occurs first), provided students continue to meet eligibility criteria and participate in an Annual Scholars Program event and/or ongoing communication.

About the Program

The Dr. Robert A. Scott Memorial Scholars Program provides scholarship support to selected students graduating from high schools in Southcentral Pennsylvania. Scholars who are selected must maintain a minimum cumulated GPA of a 3.0 or higher. They also must be an active participant in their school through extra-curricular activities and/or volunteer in their community.

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Eligibility

Eligible students for this scholarship must:

- Be an African American male.
- Have earned at least a 3.0 grade average or equivalent in high school.
- Be engaged in community service and/or extracurricular activities.
- Be accepted for admission to an accredited college or university.
- Plan to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited college or university for the entire current academic year.
- Agree to participate in an annual Scholars Program event and/or ongoing communication with the Boulé.

Application Guidelines

Applications will be accepted **from January 1st through April 15th**. The application package must consist of:

- Completed Scholars Program Student Application Form (signed by student and parent/legal guardian)
- Completed FAFSA page indicating the amount of financial need
- Completed Essay Question Form
- Official High School Transcript
- Supplemental documents (Letters of Recommendation are welcome, but not required)

Completing the Application

- Complete the **Student Application Form** online by:
 - Downloading the application into a Microsoft Word document or open with Google Docs (if available)
 - Complete your copy of the application (typing in white sections only). *Save often!*
 - Upon completion, print, sign and obtain parent/guardian signature**Handwritten and incomplete applications will not be accepted.**
