

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUMMER READING

1. Choose two books on a topic that you find interesting. Do not look for books that are easy or short on length. You will only do well if you live the topic. Consult the online book list at <http://tinyurl.com/plshHWH9> so that you can see the books from which you may choose.
2. Choose reading that is comfortable for you. Some books are not written well and can, therefore, be laborious. Be sure to pick one that really moves.
3. By July 13, mail slips to me, Mr. Patrick. With the name of your books. Mailing address is:

4. Arrange with the librarian to bring these books with you to class for the first week of school.
5. The books should be read by August 25 at the latest. Take a lot of notes when reading!
6. Review your reading and notes again before the start of the school year.
7. You will be assigned a writing assignment during the first week of school. This will count as your first major grade of the first cycle.
