
How to Create a Video on Adobe Cloud Express

Log in to Adobe Creative Cloud Express




5. Create a new project by clicking the + icon


7. Give your video a name:




- 8. Click Next
- 9. Click Start from scratch




10. + adds a slide into the presentation



11. First create a title slide, put the title of your topic and your name:




12. Next add videos or images to create your story. Connect the app to your google drive (Save images in 1 google drive folder)



13. Either upload a photo or import from Google Drive




14. You are limited in your editing so you may need to create your images on Google Slides to avoid the app cropping photos.




15. Some students opt to create all of their visuals on Google Slides first and then import in the JPEGS:



16. Press and hold the microphone to record narration. Hold the microphone for 3 seconds after you speak (in silence) so the program does not clip your voice. Make sure you do this on the last slide especially.



17. Additional editing features allow you to change the theme of the presentation, view of the video (widescreen/square) and add music. **Make sure the music does not overpower your narration.**



18. When you finish the video, preview it. Then click **download**. That will make the video an MP4. Upload that to your Google Classroom assignment. Unfortunately sharing the files does not work with google classroom.
