

Allotment report: April 2024

The allotment group has recently reorganised the monthly gatherings / meetings so that they fall on alternate Saturdays and Sundays at the beginning of the month.

Periodically meetings also take place in local eateries to support local businesses. The last such meeting was in Perfect Blend opposite Streatham Hill station.

Allotment group members have re-joined the Lambeth Horticultural Society. Members are paying subs and we are making some larger purchases such as a glasshouse. Other items previously suggested for purchase include
